You are receiving this letter to provide public notice of an upcoming Virtual Neighborhood Meeting for a proposed Development Plan Revision to Tuck Away PUD located at Map 106, Parcel 00800 at 1190 Lewisburg Pike in Franklin, TN. The applicant is proposing a revision to the Development Plan to request modification of standards for sidewalk connection and cross access easement. The use and the square footage of the buildings are not changing. The meeting will be held on Tuesday, April 07, 2026 at 5:30 pm CST, and you are invited to join the virtual Zoom Meeting:

Why are you receiving this letter?

The proposed project is within 500' of your property.

What is the purpose of the meeting?

The purpose of the meeting is to make citizens aware of a potential new development within your immediate vicinity and allow you to engage with the applicant early in the review process. The meeting is meant to be informative and provide an opportunity to ask questions directly to the developers about the project. If the project continues with a formal application to the city, it will go through a Public Hearing process. Please be aware that Public Hearings do **not** involve a question and answer session.

Will the project be voted on at this meeting?

No. The neighborhood meeting is for informational purposes only. The project, should the applicant continue with a formal application, will be reviewed by the Franklin Municipal Planning Commission (FMPC) on Thursday, April 23, 2026. The FMPC meeting will be publicly noticed and will include time for citizens to speak to the project at formal Public Hearing sessions.

5:30 – 5:35 pm	directions on how/when to comment; time to ask quick format questions
5:35 – 5:55 pm	formal presentation by the applicant to discuss the main points of the plan
5:55 – 6:30 pm	question and answer time; citizens will ask questions within the forum so all in attendance can hear and/or read each question

THIS DEVELOPMENT PLAN REVISION IS TO ASK FOR 3
MODIFICATION OF STANDARDS:

- MOS #1: A modification request establishing a cross access easement to the north but delaying the construction of the connection until development occurs to the north. Connection to be made by developer of property to the north.
- MOS #2: A modification request removing pedestrian connection from Lewisburg Pike to the front door.
- MOS #3: A modification requesting the delaying of sidewalk construction along Lewisburg Pike until sidewalk is constructed to the property line from adjacent property owners to the north or south.
